One scholarship will be awarded in 2021 in the amount of \$500.00.

Short Essays (at least 100 words, not over 300)

Tell me about a personal achievement that makes you proud.

Why do you need this scholarship?

Tell me about a mistake you made and what you learned from that time.

Essay (at least 500 words)

What impact did the Italian immigrants have on the Economic Development of Galveston County during the period of 1890-1965?

Alternative option: Submit a video introducing yourself, answering the Basic Questions, Additional Questions, presenting your short essay, and also presenting your 500 word essay. Videos submitted may be played for attendees at the festival.

DLIFGC Italian Immigrant Information Form must be submitted with application.

Winner will be announced at the Festival on March 13, 2021 and will present their 500 word essay at the festival.
